As noted last week, the CPS Environment Committee will be running a working bee to set up vegetable garden beds here at the school. These beds will initially be used by Year two students as part of the Coal Loader project. The beds will go on to form an important component of the whole school Sustainability education program.

### **NANYIMA WAITING LIST POLICY**

The following is an excerpt from our policy document which can be found on our website, [www.nanyima.com.au](http://www.nanyima.com.au)

“Under agreement with the Commonwealth Government the main priority for a place in the centre will be given to:

- Priority 1 – a child at risk of serious abuse or neglect
- Priority 2 – a child of a single parent who satisfies, or of parents who both satisfy, the work/training/study test under section 14 of the *A New Tax System (Family Assistance) Act 1999*
- Priority 3 – any other child

Within these main categories priority will also be given to the following children:

- children in Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander families
- children in families which include a disabled person
- children in families on low incomes
- children in families from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds
- children in socially isolated families
- children of single parents

The waiting list is checked and updated daily; if you are currently on our waiting list you will be contacted immediately a place becomes available.
