The Premier's Reading Challenge program for 2010 is up and running at Cammeray School. All children are encouraged to participate. ### **PROPOSED EXTENSION TO SCHOOL BUS ROUTE 660 - AN UPDATE**

Thank you to everyone who phoned and registered their interest. There has been progress but not what I had anticipated!

Willoughby Bus Depot has identified a current but mostly under-utilised service - the 663 - which is an afternoon school bus from Neutral Bay Public School to McClelland St Willoughby. Currently it passes Cammeray School (Palmer St) at approx 3.35pm, then carries on through Northbridge and along Eastern Valley Way to McClelland St.

At present it is empty at Cammeray and I have assurances that no secondary school students catch the bus. If we are interested then we can create a new pick up for the bus at Cammeray (Palmer St).

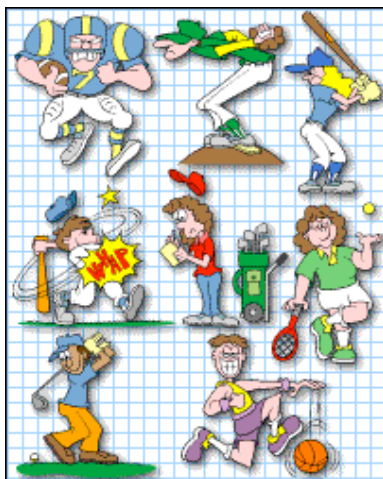
